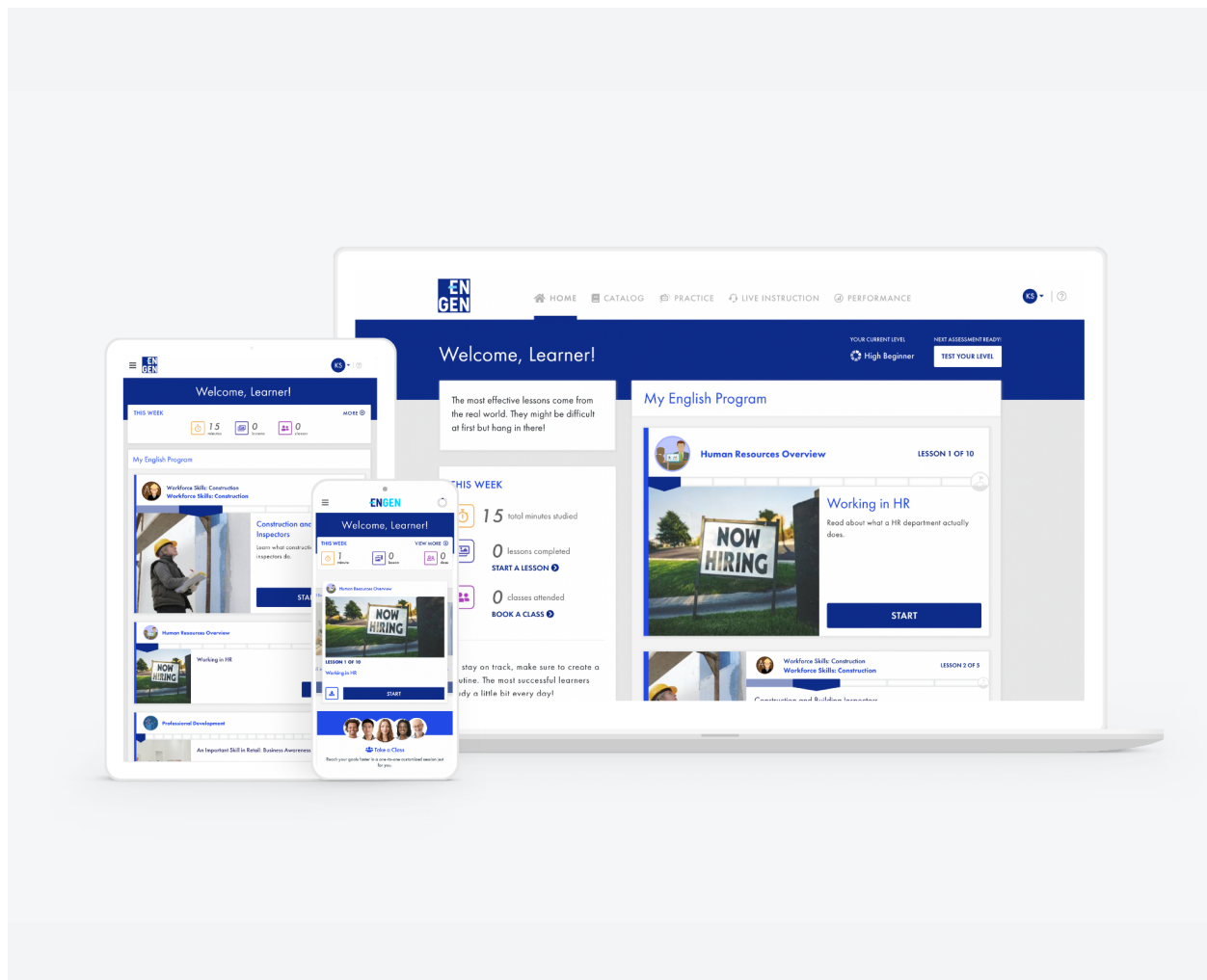

The EnGen platform can be accessed from your computer or mobile device, anytime day or night.

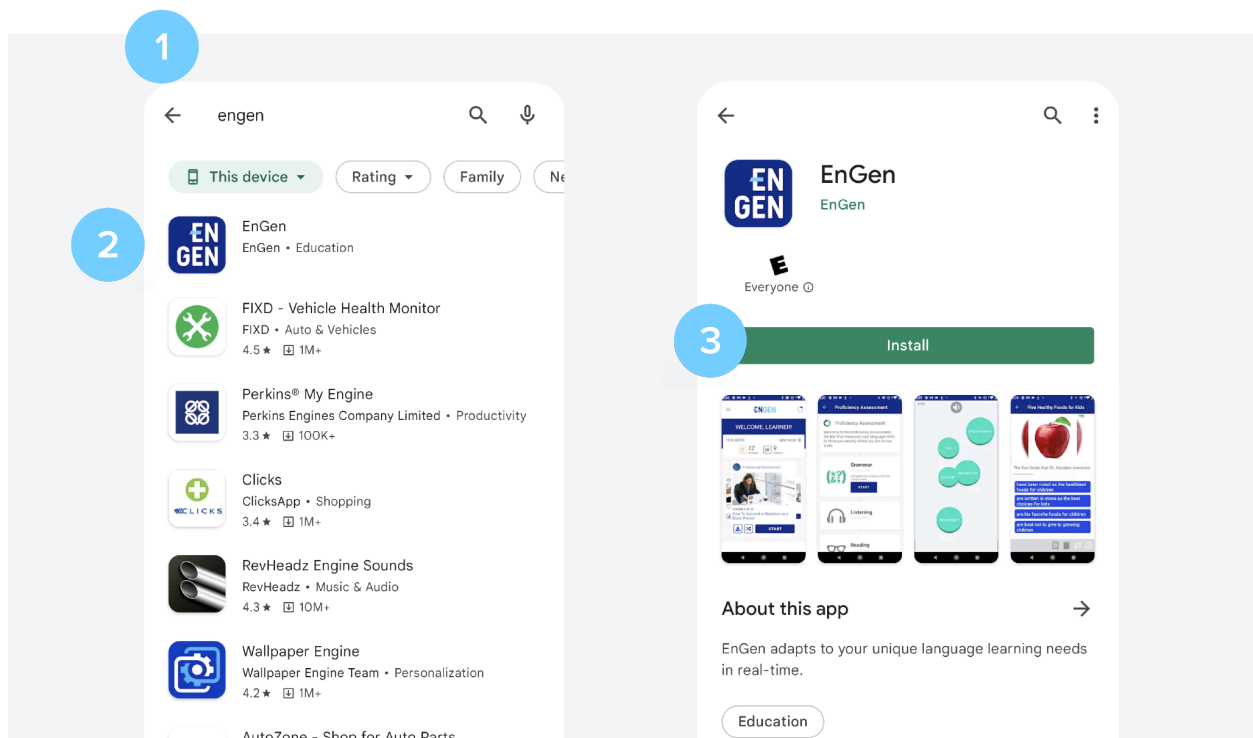


Available on Android and iOS systems.

How to install the EnGen App:

1. Search **EnGen** in the **Google Play Store** or **Apple's App Store** on your device
2. Click on the **EnGen** icon
3. Click **Install**. After the install is complete, click **Open**.



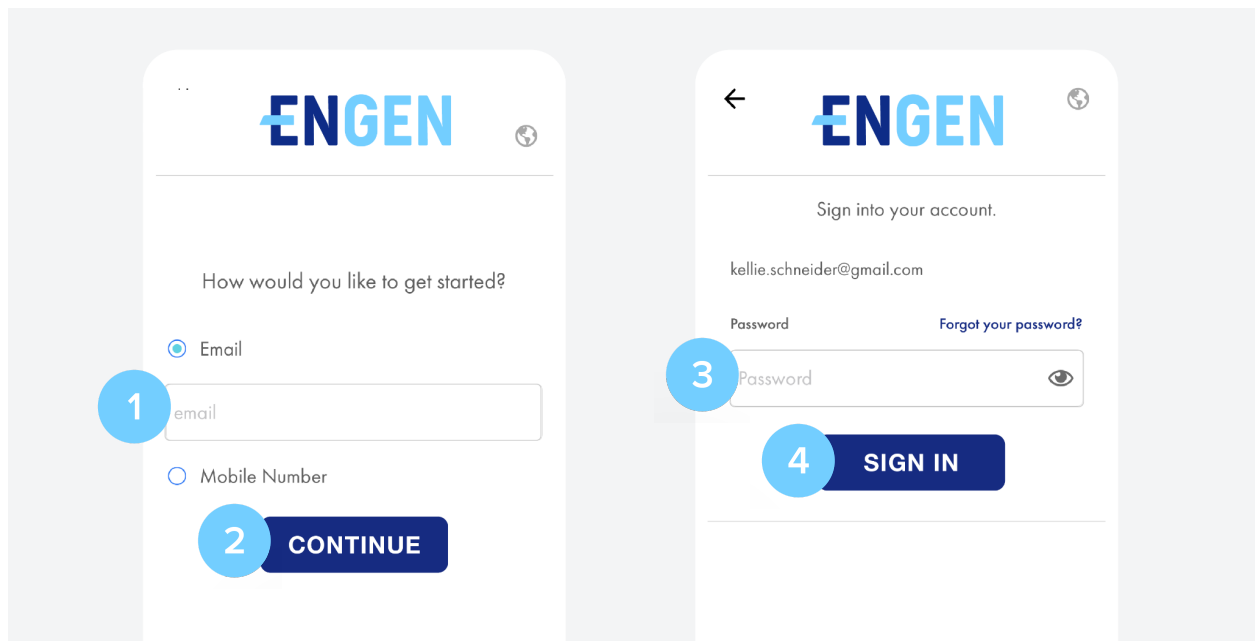
Logging In with Email

How to log in to the EnGen App with email:

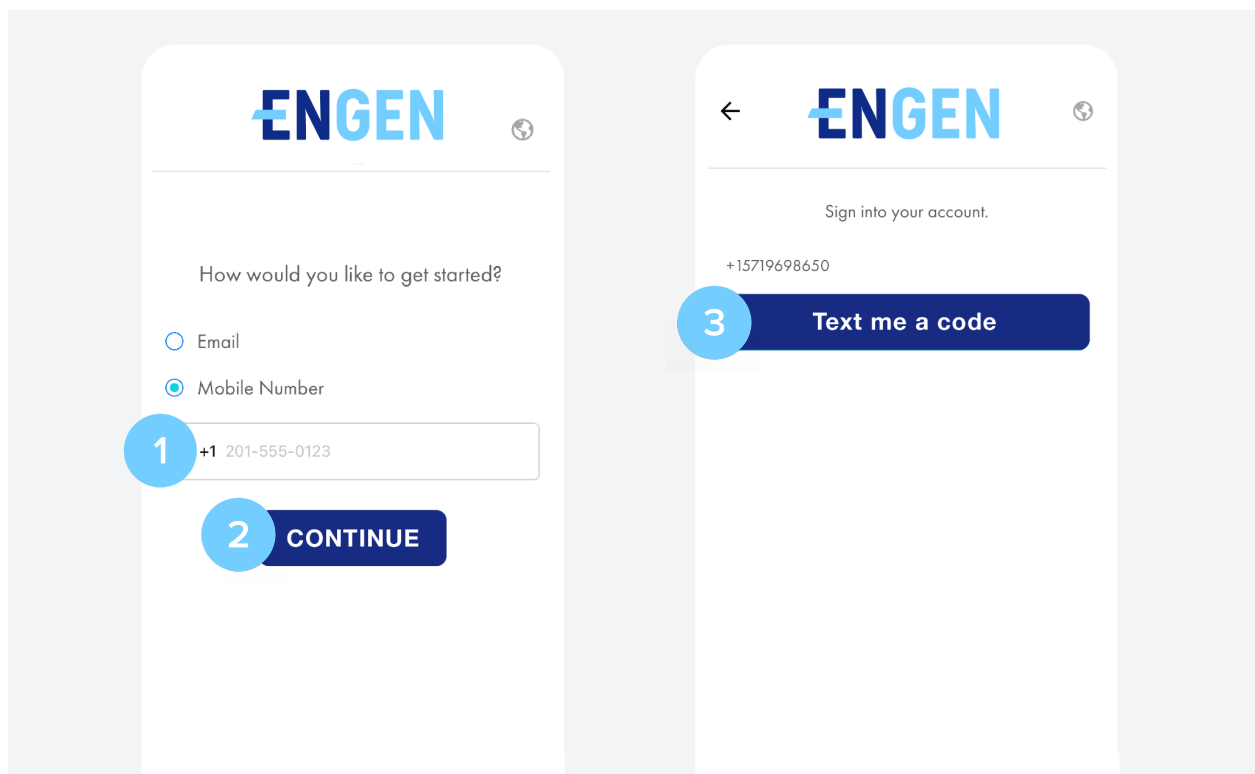
1. Select **Email**, and enter your email address in the field

4. Click **Sign In**



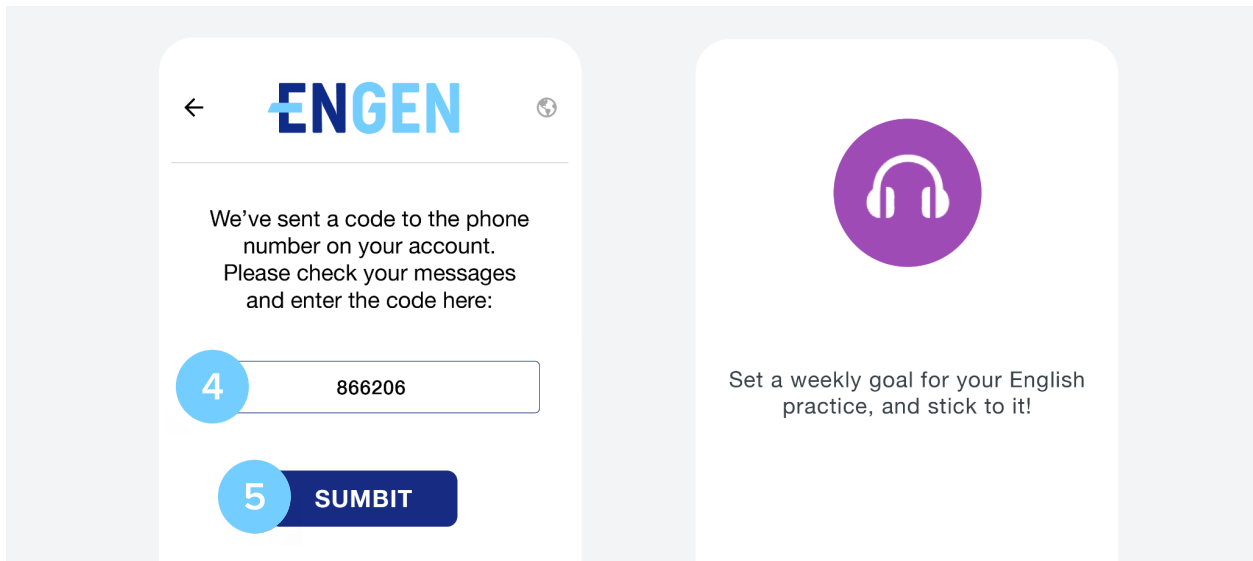
Logging In with Phone Number

5. Click **Submit**. Wait as your program is enabling

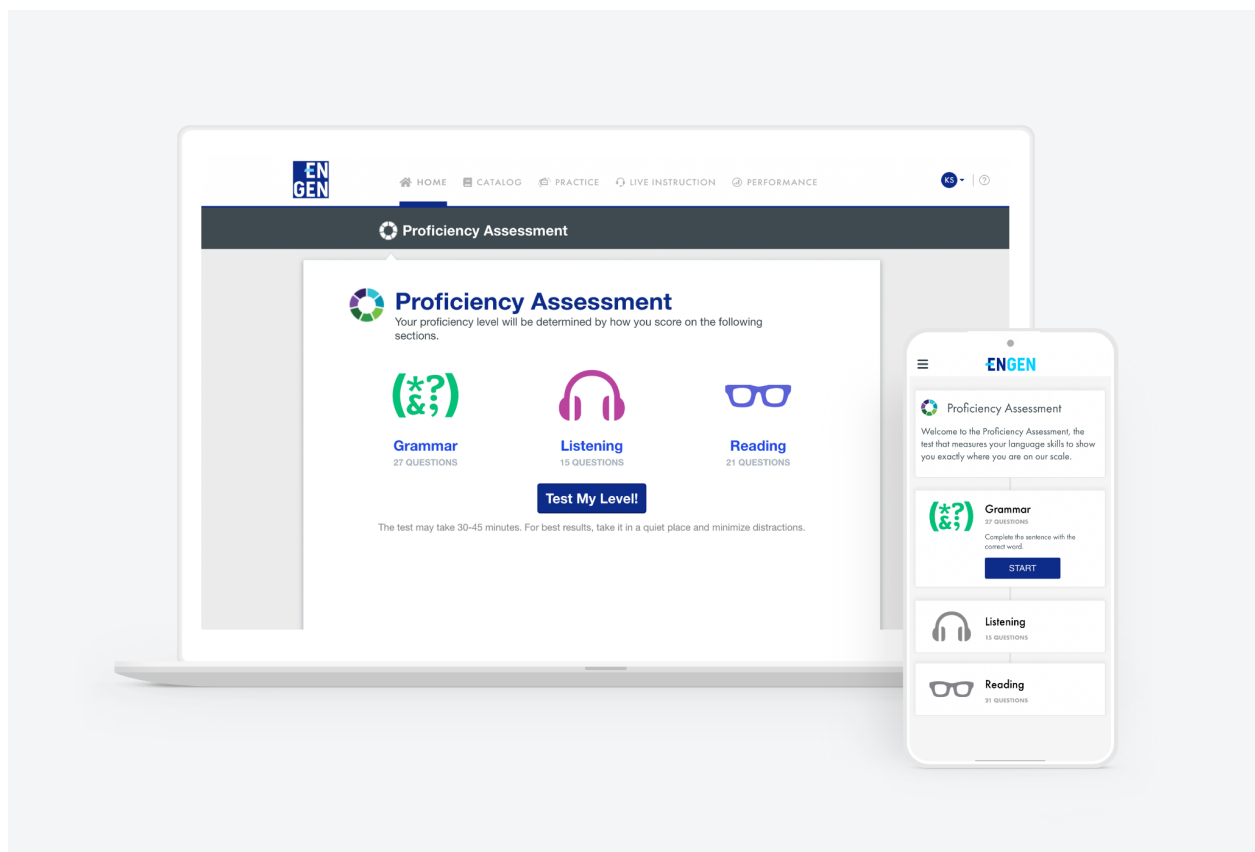


What Do I Do First?

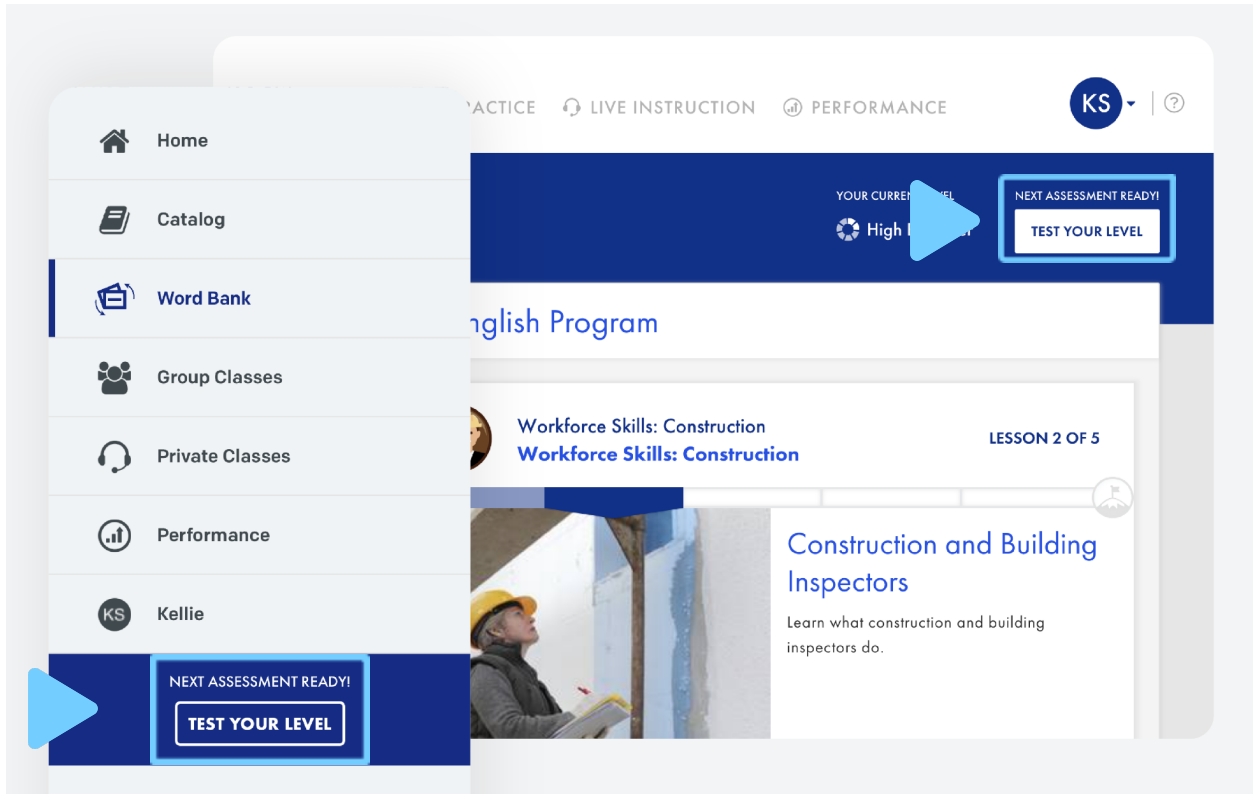
How to complete the Proficiency Assessment:

EnGen needs to learn about you, so we ask you to complete a **short survey**. This can be completed in the mobile app or on the computer.

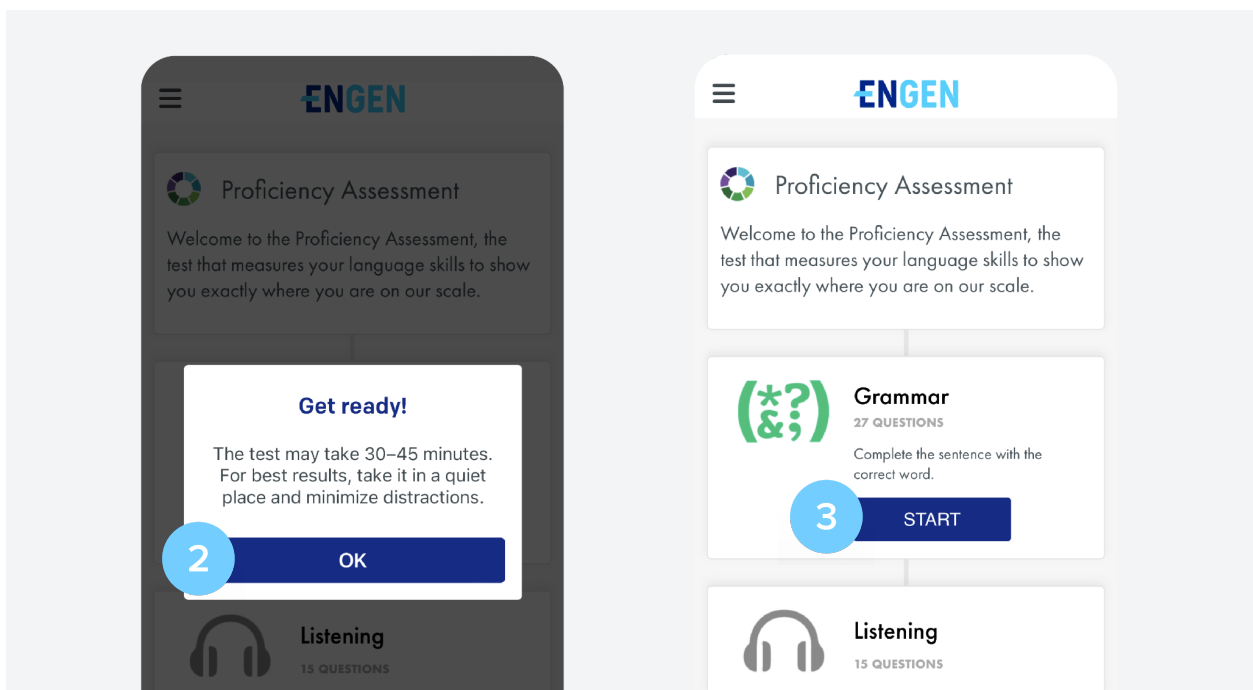


1. Click **Test Your Level**



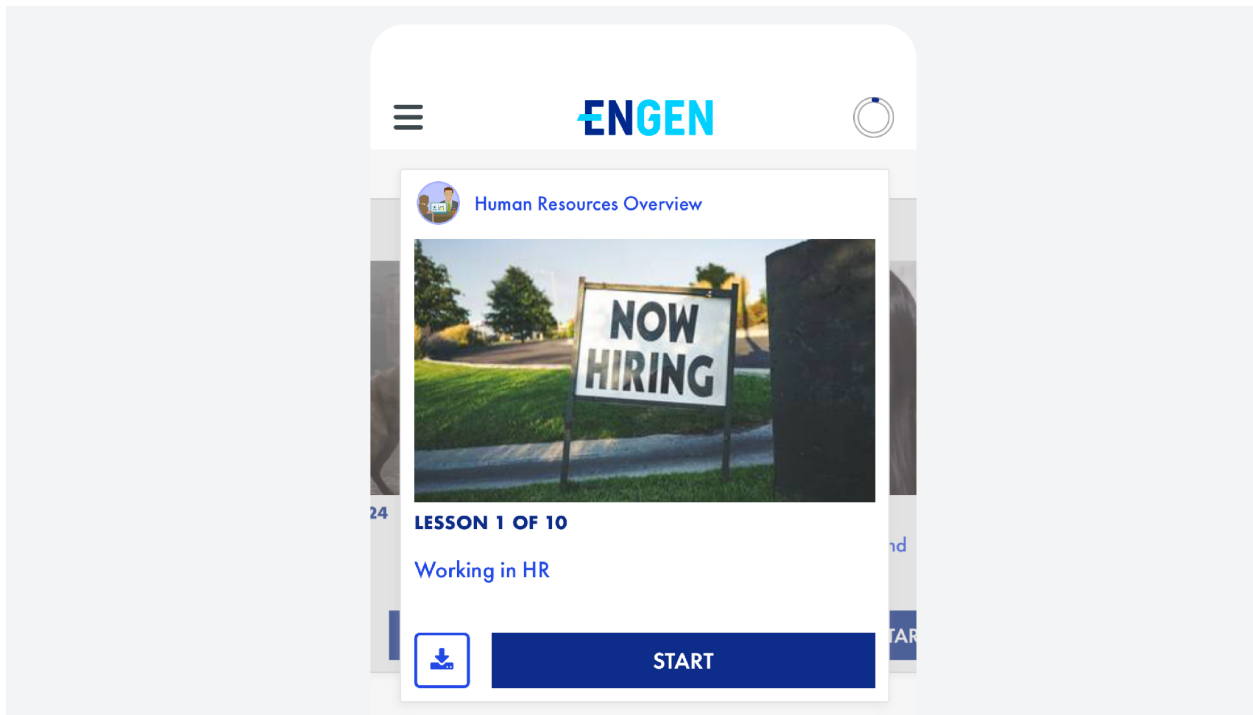
2. This test can take up to 45 minutes. When ready to Start press **OK**

3. Click **Start**



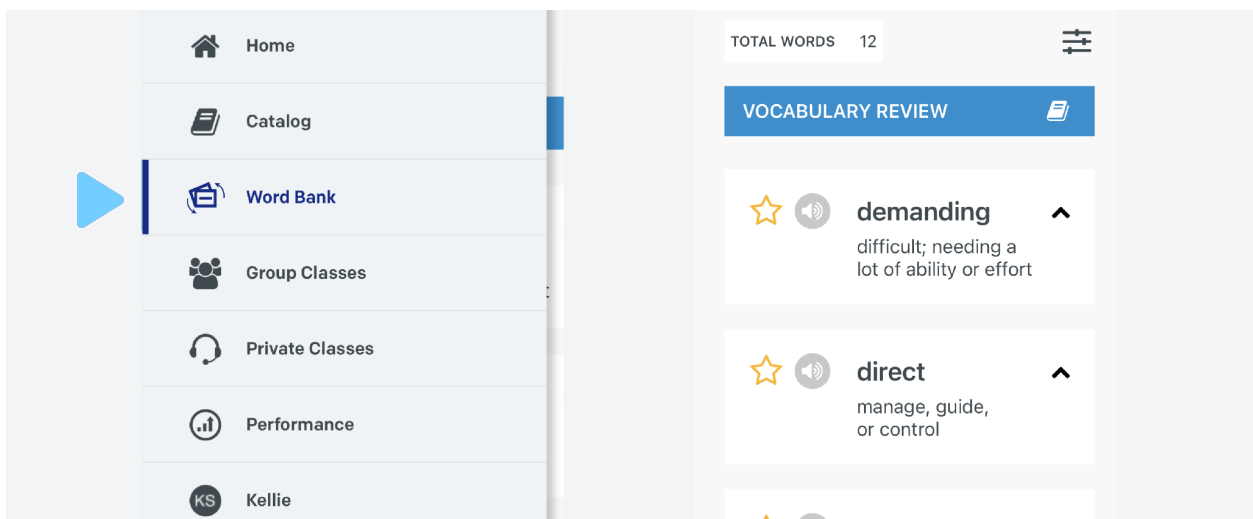
Starting My English Program

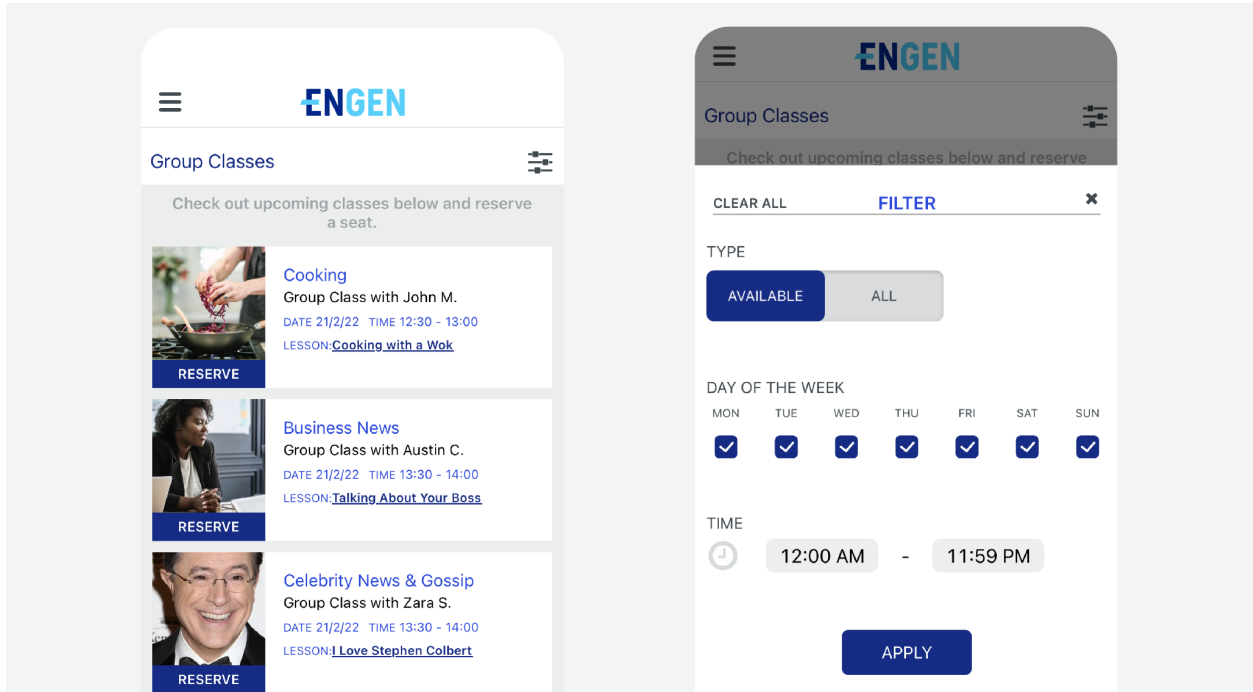

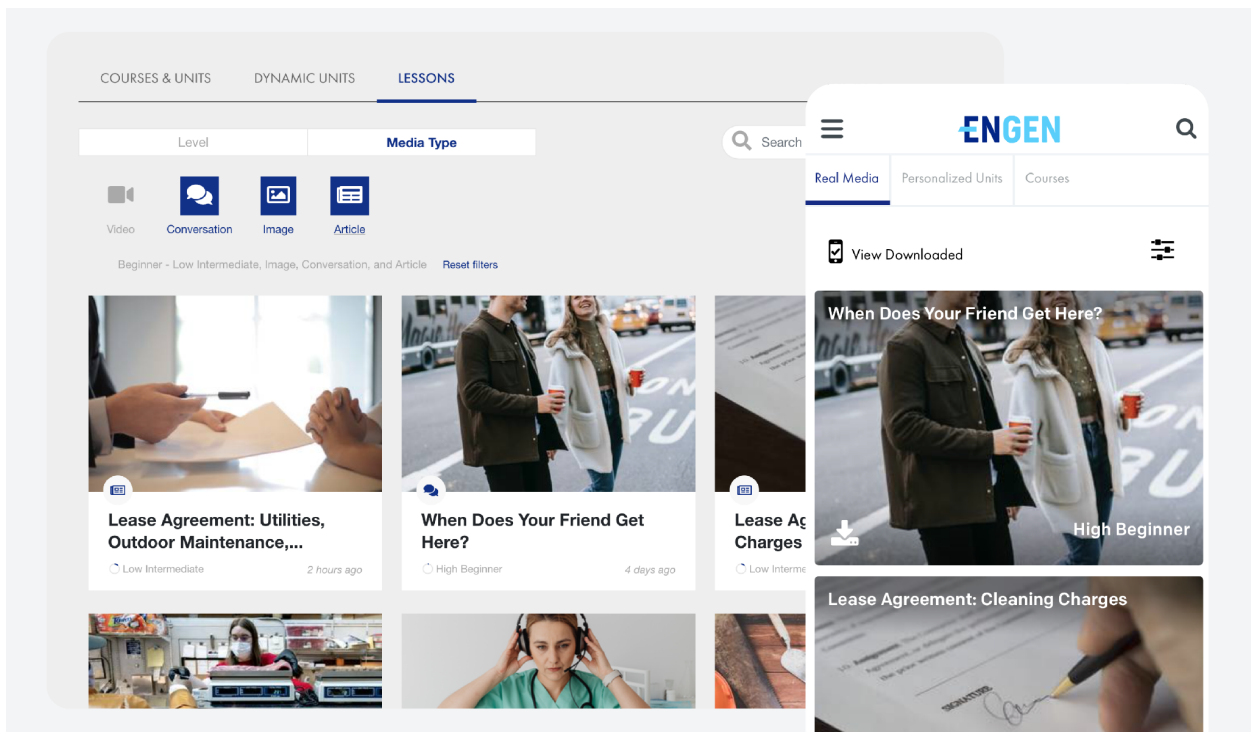

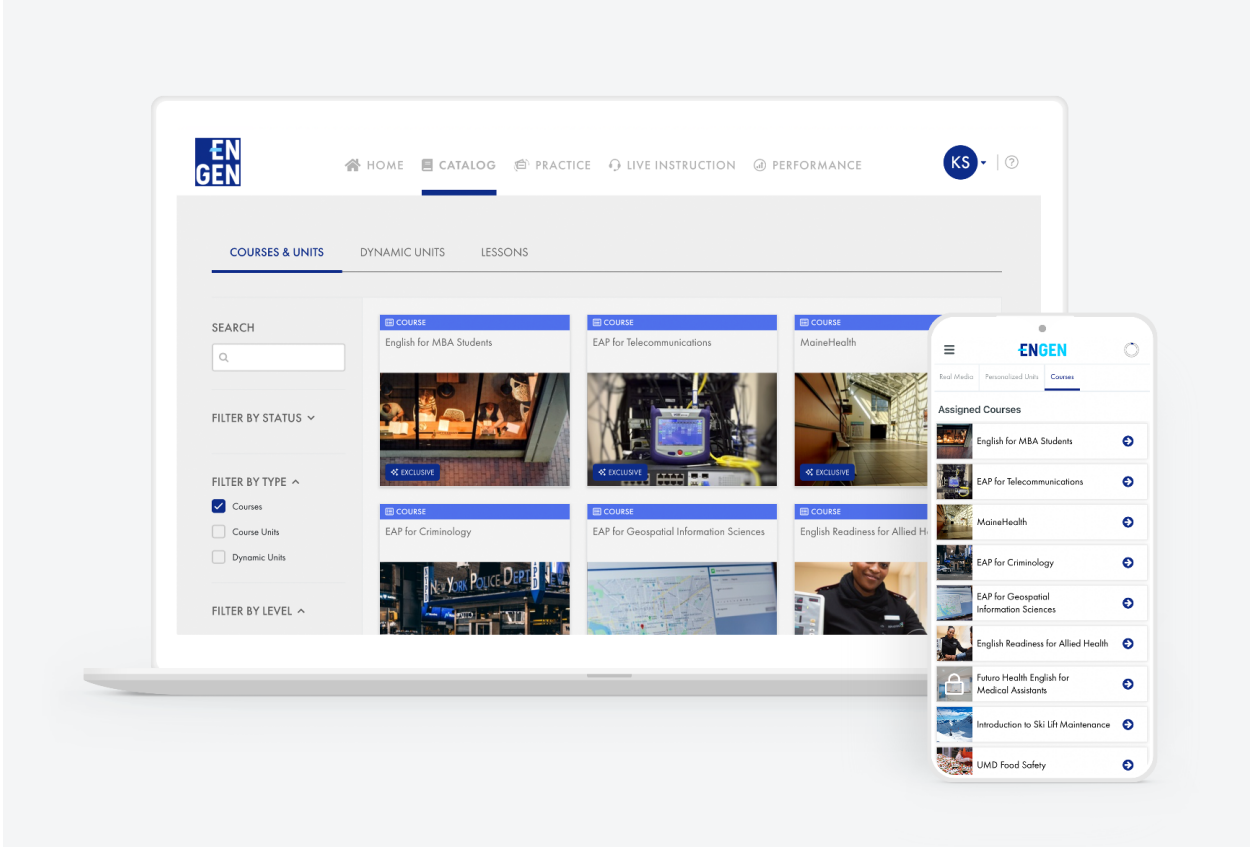
